Fees

Zoom – 30 min talk plus 15mins Q&A, if desired. £78.50. Payable in advance.

In Person - a flat fee of £170 to cover talk and train, tube and bus travel.

A lift to and from your nearest station would prevent having to add taxi fares on top of this.

In-Person requirements

Paulus's round-trip to appear as your speaker is typically around 6hrs in length. He requires 45mins to prepare and get changed in an appropriate 'dressing room' with a table and chair and electrical plug socket, where he can safely keep his valuables during the talk. A toilet is not acceptable. Nor is a store cupboard with mouse traps and no heating (yes, these things have happened). Bottled water or a cup of tea is always appreciated.
